This demonstrates the importance of the environment, for no one acting on the child from without can cause him to concentrate. Only he can organize his psychic life. None of us can do it for him."

"Little he cares for the knowledge of others. He wants to acquire a knowledge of his own"

"Never let a child fail until he has a reasonable chance of success"
